

Opkey is a no-code, AI-driven continuous testing platform designed to optimize software testing by reducing time, effort, and costs. It ensures seamless alignment with release cycles, minimizes risk, and supports uninterrupted business operations.

Opkey University is an online learning platform where users can learn Opkey at their own pace through structured courses, hands-on simulation exercises, assessments, and troubleshooting guides. It provides role-based and technology-focused training, enabling users to gain expertise in Opkey's test automation capabilities for specific applications and technologies.

Users can earn lifetime-valid certifications to validate their skills.

This guide is designed for users new to the Opkey test automation platform, providing step-by-step instructions to ensure effective learning.








Step 3: Search any **course** by its **name, or use course category and type filters**

Step 4: Click the **ENROLL** button on the course you want to start **learning**



Step 3: Click the **"START LEARNING TODAY"** button to continue learning your courses




